NEW AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING TO BE DEDICATED

Vero Beach, Florida – The Vero Beach Municipal Airport will host a Dedication Ceremony for the completely renovated Airport Terminal Building (3400 Cherokee Drive, Vero Beach) on October 31, 2008, at 10:30 A.M.

The completely renovated C. J. Cannon's Restaurant section as well as the newly constructed airport lobby and administrative offices section have both received positive reviews from restaurant patrons, FAA personnel, pilots, and many citizens who have already visited the new facility. New office space is now available for lease to selected aviation and non-aviation businesses.

The airport terminal was 65% paid for with funds from the Florida Department of Transportation which were collected from the taxes on the sale of aviation fuel. The remaining 35% of the project was paid for from revenues collected from businesses and pilots who operate at the Vero Beach Airport. No local property taxes or income taxes were used to fund the airport project.

The Mayor of the City of Vero Beach, Thomas P. White, will be on hand to welcome the public and read a proclamation, dedicating the new airport terminal to the City and its users and business owners. In addition, U.S. Congressman Dave Weldon, and Airport Commission Chairman Peter Coxhead, who have shown strong support for this and other Vero Beach Airport projects, will be in attendance to say a few words. The public is invited to attend.

A small cake and coffee reception immediately following the event is being catered by C.J. Cannon's restaurant.
